He will also give an undertaking about the travel history of the visiting person and copy of permission of the competent authority on which they have come to this place. In case of non-intimation, it will be sole responsibility of the concerned employee. The visitors must adhere to the health advisory/guidelines from the Medical Staff. Besides, it is also emphasised that it may also be ensured that the Aarogya Setu App is invariably downloaded by all students and employees and the health status on the same is updated frequently by them. Any violation of the order shall attract penal action in terms of H.P Epidemic Disease (Covid-19) Amendment Regulation, 2020.
