

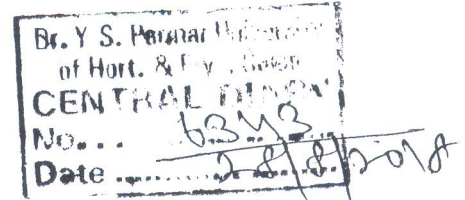

Dear Colleague,

The University's **International Summer Programmes (7 July – 17 August 2019)** offer a heady mixture of tradition and innovation, as hundreds of students absorb the atmosphere of this remarkable place, learning from some of the finest academics, and from each other. The Programmes have a reputation for excellent teaching, fascinating courses and intriguing lectures.

Over 200 courses make up the open-access programmes, which include History, Science, Ancient and Classical Worlds, Creative Writing, Interdisciplinary, Art and Visual Culture, Literature and Shakespeare, Medieval Studies, Business and Entrepreneurship, and an English Law and Legal Methods Programme for those from non-Common Law countries.

At the core of most programmes are small, special study classes, complemented by plenary lectures and evening talks. Teaching is delivered by subject specialists from within the University and beyond. Around 50% of participants each year are current undergraduate or graduate students; the rest are adults of all ages and backgrounds, from over 60 different countries. Some 50% of all participants are aged 30+.

In 2019 we will also be launching a Pre-University Programme for 16-18 year olds combining lectures, study-skills sessions and supervisions.

Applications open in December (January for the Pre-University Programme); our website will have full details about the Programmes, dates, accommodation options and fees, along with information about how to apply online: www.ice.cam.ac.uk/intsummer. We will also send you a copy of our 2019 prospectus.
