

COH&F Neri gets ICAR accreditation

In a significant achievement, the College of Horticulture and Forestry (COH&F), Neri in Hamirpur, which is a constituent college of the Dr YS Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry (UHF), Nauni has been granted accreditation by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi. The college was established in the year 2011 as an Institute of Biotechnology and Environmental Science. In 2014, it was renamed as College of Horticulture and Forestry, thus becoming the third constituent College of the University.



The university has started the accreditation process in November 2017. The accreditation committee had first visited the college in December last year. This year in June, Dr NS Rathore, Deputy Director General (Education) visited the campus to verify the recommendations of the accreditation certification committee. After meeting all the standards of ICAR, the college was granted recognition for a period of five years.
