NOTICE

This is for the information of all concerned that the Vice-Chancellor, after considering several requests from candidates and after holding a meeting with the concerned Deans at the Main Campus, has approved the **increase in the number of Self-Financing seats** for the **Second Round of Counselling under the Master's Degree Programmes** for the Academic Session 2025-26.

It has also been approved to relax the provision of **Clause 6.3.3 of Chapter VI** of the Prospectus of the Undergraduate and Master's Degree Programmes for Academic Session 2025-26, whereby the **cut-off marks** for appearing in counselling under the **Self-Financing category** have been lowered to **35 marks and above in PGET-2025** for participation in the counselling/admission process. The **cut-off for Normal Seats** shall, however, shall remain unchanged i.e. **45 marks and above**.

However, candidates seeking admission under **Self-Financing Seats** with marks between **35 and 44 marks** in the entrance shall be required to pay an **additional tuition fee** (as prescribed below), over and above the prescribed Self-Financing fee.

Schedule for the Second Round of offline Counselling

- **Venue:** Dr. L.S. Negi Auditorium, Main Campus, Nauni (Solan)
- **Date:** 01.09.2025
- **Reporting Time:** **10:00 AM to 11:00 AM (for marking attendance)**

Further, the cut-off marks for eligibility to appear in the Second Round of Counselling for the Master's Programme for **Normal** and **Self-Finance** seats are provided below:

Documents to be brought at the time of counselling (along with one set of self-attested copies):

- i. Matriculation certificate (for proof of date of birth)
- ii. 10+2 marks sheet
- iii. Graduate degree certificate / Provisional Degree Certificate (PDC)
- iv. Transcript of Academic Record / Detailed marks sheet
- v. Character certificate from the institute last attended
- vi. HP Domicile Certificate (compulsory for all HP candidates applying for normal seats)
- vii. SC/ST/EWS/PwD certificate (if applicable)
- viii. Sports/NCC/NSS/ Scouts/ Co-curricular activities certificate
- ix. Any other relevant certificates

Counselling Fee

All eligible and interested candidates appearing for the first time in the counselling for Normal and Self-Financing Seats of the Master's Degree Programme are required to pay a **non-refundable counselling fee of ₹1000/-**.

- The payment must be made through the **QR Code/Link provided in Annexure-I** and bring the receipt generated through the e-Shiksha portal.
- Candidates who have already paid the requisite fee during the previous round of counselling must bring a **hard copy proof of the payment receipt** generated from the **e-Shiksha Portal**. Only such receipts will be considered valid at the counselling venue.

Important Instructions for Counselling

1. Mere payment of the counselling fee does not guarantee seat allotment. Seats will be allotted strictly as per the **merit of the entrance test**, availability of seats, and the provisions and eligibility criteria mentioned in the **Prospectus for the Master's Programmes, Academic Session 2025-26**.
2. It is **mandatory** for all candidates to mark their attendance and appear before the **Chairman of the Counselling Committee**.
3. Candidates who fail to appear before the Chairman after marking attendance will not be considered for admission.
4. **Candidates seeking admission under the Sports and Co-Curricular Activities Quota are required to present themselves before the Counselling Committee. Allotment of seats under this category shall commence sharply at 11:00 AM and will be made strictly on the basis of attendance, merit in Sports/Co-Curricular Activities, and provisions of the Prospectus.**
5. Candidates arriving after the reporting time or don't report to the chairman of the counselling committee on time will be considered for seat allotment only against any vacancies available at that time.
6. Admissions shall be carried out strictly in accordance with the **Prospectus** and any subsequent amendments issued by the University.
7. Candidates are advised to **regularly visit the University Website** for updates and further instructions.

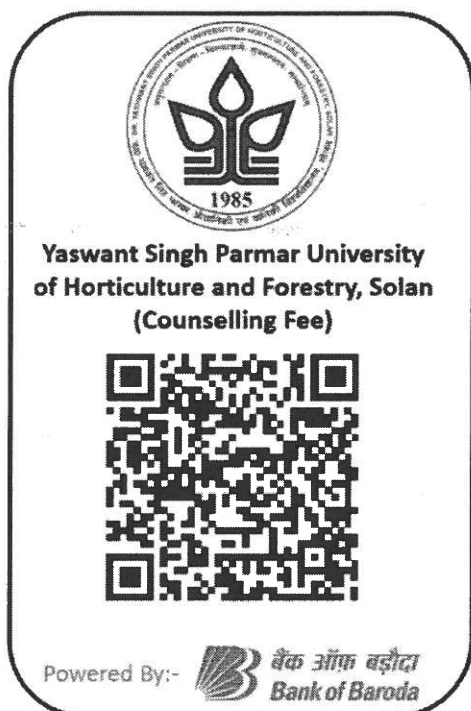
