Sir.

This has reference to the letter No.UHF/IDP/1-70(overseas)/23/-613-619 dated 14.09.2023 vide which the committee was constituted to devise parameters/criteria for evaluating the weightage of sports/games; cultural and co-curricular activities for selecting 10 students who have excelled in these activities.

The following criteria and modalities are proposed:

- 1. Applications may be invited from the eligible candidates having a minimum OGPA of 7.5 for General Category (UR) and 7.0 for SC/ST candidates for consideration.
- 2. It is proposed that one student each from 2nd, 3rd and 4th Year of UG Programmes per College at the main campus and two students each from 3rd and 4th year (one each from B.Sc. (Horticulture) and B.Sc. (Forestry)) from College of Horticulture and Forestry, Neri may be considered so that all batches get equal opportunity and fair representation. If possible, one student each from B. Sc. (Horticulture) 2nd year and one from B.Sc. (Forestry) 2nd year at CoH&F, Neri may be considered.
- 3. Only one sport and one co-curricular activity certificate per year, which is most beneficial to the candidate, will be considered.
- 4. Score of different sports and co-curricular activities of last four academic years (upto 30th September, 2023) will be considered.
- 5. In case of a tie, the candidate elder in age will be considered.
- 6. Marks to be allotted for various sports/games/cultural activities are given below:
