

Tender details: The tender documents shall be uploaded online in 2 covers.

Cover 2 : Shall contain BOQ/financial bids, where contractor will quote his offer for each item.

6. **Submission of Original Documents :** The bidders are required to submit (a) Original demand draft towards the cost of bid document and (b) Original bid security/earnest money deposit (EMD) in shape of FDR duly pledged in favour of the Director, Extension Education, UHF Nauni and other technical documents in O/o the undersigned as the specified in key dates on tender opening date, failing which the bids will be declared non responsive. It is also mandatory to visit the site of work w.e.f. 14.03.2025 to uploading date of tender on any working day between 10.00 AM to 5.00 PM upto 24.03.2025. All the documents/certificates should be submitted physically which are essentially required prequalification criteria and technical evaluation. List and scoring pattern available online of technical evaluation criteria as well as pre qualification criteria. Drawing of civil, electrical and water supply work also available online alongwith specifications.
7. **Bid Opening detail:** The bids shall be opened on 25.03.2025 at 11.10 AM in the office of the Executive Engineer (D) UHF Nauni Solan by the authorized officer/officials. In their interest the tenderer are advised to be present alongwith original documents at the time of opening of tender. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.

7.2 Technical Evaluation Criteria

This round will evaluate the technical proposal considering both the submitted proposal and their presentation. Each evaluated proposal will be given a technical score (TS), with a maximum score of 100, based on the technical proposal. Only those proposals whose technical scores are 70 or more out of a maximum of 100 will qualify for further consideration and will be ranked from highest to lowest based on their technical score.
