About the Raichur City

Nestling between Tungabhadra and Krishna rivers, Raichur is bestowed with major irrigation projects to cater the needs of the farming community. The region is being regarded as "Rice and Pulse bowls" of Karnataka. Historically, the city was ruled by great empires like Mouryas, Chalukyas, Bahamanis and Vijayanagara kings.

The City also harbours two thermal power stations (KPTCL and YTPS) which contribute around 40 per cent of power generation in Karnataka. The World heritage centre Hampi (the ruins of Vijayanagara kingdom) is around 150 km from the city and famous Golgumbaz of Vijayapur, Badami and Aihole are within 200 km from the city. The famous religious temple, Raghavendraswamy temple, Mantralayam is 40 km from the city.

How to Reach Raichur

Raichur is well connected by Road, Train from all major cities in India and nearest airport is RGI airport, Hydarabad (200 km).

By Air:

- 1. Nearest Airport: the nearest airport is the Kalaburagi Airport (KUL) which is approximately 150 km (93 miles) from Raichur.
- Other Options: You can also fly to Hyderabad International Airport (HYD), which is around 200 km (150 miles) from Raichur, or Bengaluru international Airport (BLR), which is around 410 km (255 miles) from Raichur.

By Train:

- 1. Raichur Railway Station: Raichur has its own railway station, which is connected to major cities
- 2. Trains: Regular trains are available from nearby cities like Kalaburagi, Vijayapura, and Bellany.

By Road:

- Highway Connectivity: Raichur is connected to nearby cities via national highway, including NH-167 and NH-150A
- Distance: Raichur is approximately 410 km (255 miles) from Bengaluru 200 km (150 miles) from Hyderabad, and 150 km (93 miles) from Kalaburagi.

During Month of December Raichur weather is pleasant with mild cold conditions. Woollen cloths required during the event.




