NOTICE

The Bank of Baroda, under its Education Outreach Initiative for the FY 2025-26, has proposed to conduct the “Baroda Achievers Award Ceremony” at the University. Under one of the categories, namely “Best All-Rounder”, an award of ₹31,000/- shall be conferred upon the selected student.

Accordingly, applications are invited for the “Best All-Rounder” award from eligible B.Sc./B.Tech students admitted during the Academic Session 2022-23 and presently in their final year of Degree Programme. The applicant must have secured an Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of 7.50/10.00 or above up to the 6th Semester of the Degree Programme, without having obtained an “F” or “US” grade in any course during the programme.

The eligible students may submit self-attested copies of certificates pertaining to Sports and Extra-Curricular Activities (including NCC/NSS and Cultural Activities, if any) earned during their Degree Programme for the Academic Sessions 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 only. The activities must be recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) or the Government of Himachal Pradesh for consideration of candidature for conferment of the “Bank of Baroda Achievers Award for the Best All-Rounder Student”, in accordance with the provisions contained in Academic Regulations 15.12.2 and 15.12.3 (**copy annexed**).

The certificates must be submitted positively **on or before 06.03.2026** on the email at deancof@uhf.ac.in with the subject line “**Certificates for the Best All-Rounder**”. The email must clearly mention the name of the student, father’s name, admission number and OGPA up to the 6th Semester, along with clear and legible scanned copies of the relevant certificates. Applications received after the due date or without the requisite details shall not be considered, and no claim in this regard shall be entertained thereafter.

4. Any matter not specifically covered under these guidelines shall be decided by the Committee with the approval of the Competent Authority, whose decision shall be final and binding.
